**OCT 6 BIG TROUBLE IN LITTLE CHINA**

DIR: JOHN CARPENTER / 1986 / USA / 99 MINS

Kurt Russell plays hard-boiled truck driver Jack Burton who gets caught in a bizarre conflict within, and underneath, San Francisco's Chinatown. An Ancient Chinese prince and Chinatown crime lord has kidnapped a beautiful green-eyed woman, who is the fiance to Jack's best friend. Jack must help his friend rescue the girl before the evil Lo Pan uses her to break the ancient curse that keeps him a fleshless and immortal spirit.

**OCT 6, 8 KWAIDAN**

DIR: MASAKI KOBAYASHI / JAPAN / 1965 / 183 MINS / CURRENT ROTTEN TOMATOES SCORE: 91%

After more than a decade of sober political dramas and socially minded period pieces, the great Japanese director Masaki Kobayashi shifted gears dramatically for this rapturously stylized quartet of ghost stories. Featuring colorfully surreal sets and luminous cinematography, these haunting tales of demonic comeuppance and spiritual trials, adapted from writer Lafcadio Hearn's collections of Japanese folklore, are existentially frightening and meticulously crafted.

**OCT 10 SAW (20TH ANNIVERSARY SCREENING)**

DIR: JAMES WANI / USA / 2004 / 103 MINS

Photographer Adam Stanheight (Leigh Whannell) and oncologist Lawrence Gordon (Cary Elwes) regain consciousness while chained to pipes at either end of a filthy bathroom. As the two men realize they've been trapped by a sadistic serial killer named "Jigsaw" and must complete his perverse puzzle to live, flashbacks relate the fates of his previous victims. Meanwhile, Dr. Gordon's wife (Monica Potter) and young daughter (Mackenzie Vega) are forced to watch his torture via closed-circuit video.

**OCT 22 THE OTHERS**

DIR: ALEJANDRO AMENABAR / SPAIN, FRANCE, & USA / 2001 / 104 MIN

A remote manor; hushed, candlelit atmosphere; a shivery, supernatural menace. With his first English-language feature, Chilean Spanish writer-director-composer Alejandro Amenabar resurrected the classic gothic chiller to create a ghost story of uncommon emotional resonance. Nicole Kidman stars as a World War II-era mother whose imperiousness masks a terrifying pain, as she keeps her light-sensitive children enshrouded in darkness on her country estate. The arrival of three new servants punctures her insular world - and seems to disturb the balance between the living and the dead. With each stunning twist and turn, Amenabar immerses us more deeply in a realm haunted not only by spirits but also by guilt, trauma, and repression.

**OCT 22 JACOB'S LADDER**

DIR: ADRIAN LYNE / USA / 1990 / 113 MIN

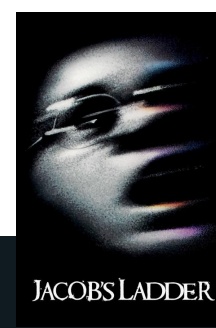
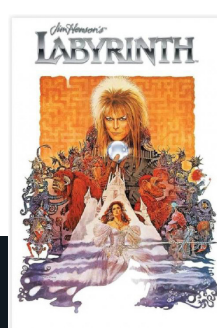
After returning home from the Vietnam War, veteran Jacob Singer (Tim Robbins) struggles to maintain his sanity while suffering from a severe case of dissociation. Plagued by traumatic visions and flashbacks, Singer rapidly falls apart as the world and people around him twist into disturbing abstractions and his days become hallucinatory hellscape.

**OCT 27 FIRE IN THE SKY**

DIR: ROBERT LIEBERMAN / USA / 1993 / 109 MIN

This film recreates the strange events which happened on November 5, 1975 in the town Snowflake, Arizona. Travis Walton works as a logger in the White Mountains. When he and his colleagues drive home after work, they encounter a flying saucer. Travis disappears without a trace and his colleagues are accused of murder. When he reappears, at first he doesn't remember that he was gone, but in time, the terrible memories come back...
